Dear friends,

I am very thankful to Roy for all that he does and all the time he dedicates to our parish. I am concerned about the finances of the parish, but I am confident that God is a good provider and that we, as His family, will be good stewards of the many things He has given us. To help me as Administrator of the Parish, I hope to form, by the end of August, both a **Pastoral Advisory Board** (like a Parish Council) and a **Finance Advisory Board** (like a Finance Council). Please, pray that the Lord will work with us to establish these important groups.

In order to grow as a family, I will post – starting next month – not only the amount of money that we collect but also the **expenses** for that month. I spoke to some of you about this idea and we seem to think it will be a good opportunity for everyone to know where the money goes. Let me know what you think.

Speaking with some of our parish office volunteers (and some of you have also pointed this out to me), we have come to the conclusion that the Parish office needs a more permanent presence. Therefore, we have decided to look for a **part-time parish secretary** who would be willing to work 5 days a week, for a total of 20-23 hours. If you are interested, or you know someone who is, send the resume to the Parish, to my attention.

I continue to thank the Lord for each one of you; My enthusiasm and excitement continues to grow as I get to know more and more of you.

Let's remain close to God for He loves each one of us immensely.

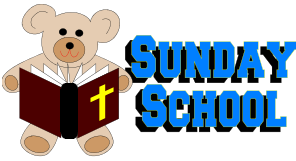
YOUNG ARTISTS CONCERT
